## Bishop Howard Visits St. Michael

On Sunday morning, April 24, St. Michael and All Angels welcomed the Right Reverend Samuel Johnson Howard, Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Florida for a Service of Confirmation, Reception and Reaffirmation of Baptismal Vows. What a glorious visit it was!

Twenty-seven members of the St. Michael and Angels family received the laying on of hands by Bishop Howard: three newly confirmed members; two who were received after transferring from the Roman Catholic church; and 22 reaffirmed their faith and commitment to the responsibilities of their Baptism. After sharing a hearty brunch with the congregation in the parish hall, Bishop Howard took the time to pose for a picture with the confirmands, those received, and many who reaffirmed their vows.

**Outreach Ministries** — Your ongoing support is needed for two new ministries at St. Michael. Please consider serving others in need by giving to these two ministries.

- Good News Outreach feeds between 120 and 150 families each week. This vital ministry receives one-third of its food from Second Harvest and depends on the community to provide the other tw0-thirds. St. Michael's goal is to donate food once per month and in April, your generosity allowed us to donate five bags of groceries. Needed foods include boxed pasta, grits, oatmeal, snacks, broths, soups, spices, flour, baking mixes, sugar, fruit cups and canned fruits. Please place your donations in the Food Gift Box in the Parish Hall.
- **Handbags of Hope** is geared toward women who have difficulty providing basic necessities for themselves. Please consider donating one of your gently used handbags filled with travel-size personal items, such as, toothbrush and toothpaste, soap, deodorant, body lotion, shampoo and conditioner, wipes and hand sanitizer. We are all very blessed so let us pay it forward and be a blessing to others. Handbags will be distributed through Economy Drug Store and Neighborhood Health Services. A clear, plastic bin has been placed in the Parish Hall to collect your donations.
