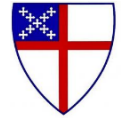

Beloved in Christ,

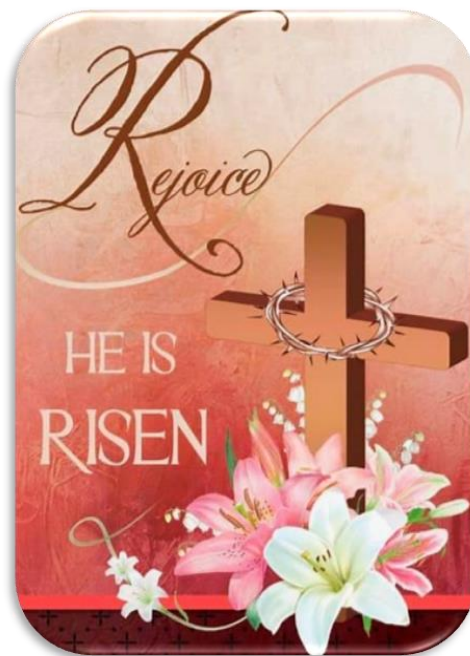
